

Basic Accessibility Checklist for Websites

- Website & Page Titles are meaningful and descriptive
- Use Properly Structured Heading (H1, H2, H3, etc.)
- Alt Text for Images and Tables
- Descriptive Hyperlinks
- Use True Tables with Headers
- Adequate color contrast & don't use color only to convey info
- Reading and navigation order is logical
- Functionality is available using keyboard only (no traps)
- Skip to content available
- Captions & transcripts are available for videos
- Ensure files are accessible (PDF, Word, PPTx, etc.)
- Check accessibility using tools available (WAVE, Sally Bb Ally)
